

Summer/Absent Yard Maintenance

S.I.G. E. Board Policy

SIGE Homeowners are responsible for maintaining their yards on a year-round basis. This can be especially difficult during summer months when weeds grow quickly during the “monsoon season” and many people are absent for extended periods. The SIGE Board approved a policy and procedure on November 7, 2013 to contact homeowners if weeds or plants become overgrown. This procedure was adopted in order to ensure the ongoing positive appearance of the neighborhood and reduce the incursion of noxious and/or pollen producing weeds.

In order for the board to follow up on this, we need to obtain contact information from all homeowners, especially when you who are away from Green Valley.
